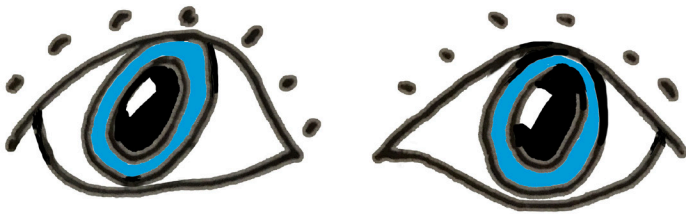


Everyday Life Learning: Poetry Walk

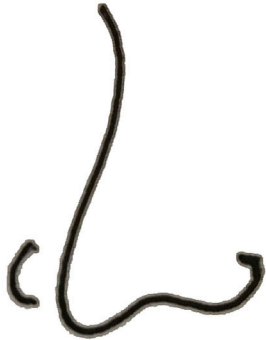

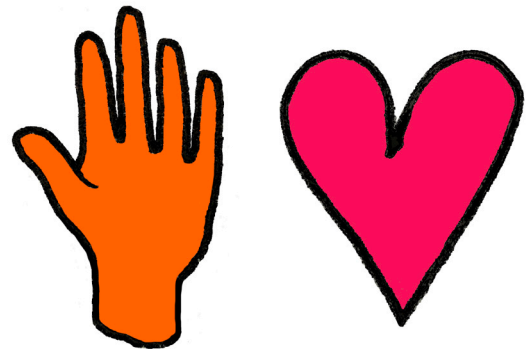
